

What to expect when flying from international destinations

Because of existing regulations for passport and visa controls you may experience some or all of the following.

At primary passport inspection:

As you submit your passport, visa and related documentation to the Customs and Border Protection Officer you may be subject to some of the following:

- Questions about your trip, country of origin, destination, contact in the U.S., address where you will be staying, etc.
- Further detailed questions about you, your family history, etc.

After primary inspection, and if the Customs and Border Protection Officer so deems necessary, you may:

- Be forwarded to NSEERS (National Security Entry-Exit Registration System) Registration for further processing.
- Be forwarded to Secondary Screening for further inquiry and/or additional document clarification.

Please make note of the following:

You may shorten waiting and processing times by properly completing all required immigration forms such as I-94 or I-94-W, Customs declarations and NSEERS registration form (if applicable).

International Traveler Pickup

International travelers exit the customs area at the far east end of the lower level bag claim of the terminal (This is to one's left upon entering the terminal). Those picking up international travelers may meet them in this area.
