

Waxleaf Ligustrum

Ligustrum japonicum/Ligustrum lucidum



Description:

- Shrub to small tree
- Grows to 25'
- Thick, glossy, opposite leaves



Fragrant clusters of small, white flowers in spring through summer



Blue berries in late summer through fall

Waxleaf Ligustrum

Ligustrum japonicum/Ligustrum lucidum

Habitat:

Disturbed areas, lowland areas and floodplains

Least Toxic Removal:

- Pull plants by hand when young
- Use Weed Wrench™ for 2.5 diameter and smaller
- Cut trees to stumps – remove sprouts as they appear

Non-Invasive Alternatives:

- Texas Sage
- Barbados Cherry

DO NOT PLANT
Spread by seeds
